

Creating an Image with Clonezilla

Insert the Clonezilla CD, plug in the External HDD (to which you will save the image), turn it on and then power on the computer. Press F12 as it boots. Choose to boot from the CD and press Enter to begin when the splash screen appears.

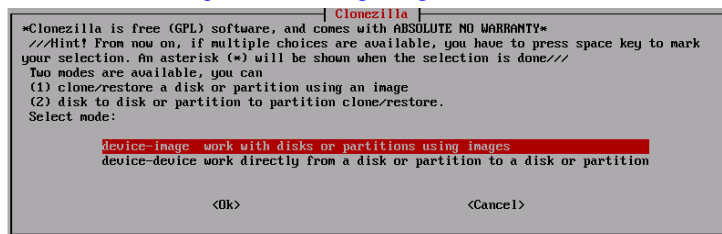


Hit “Enter” to accept en_US.UTF-8 English.

Select “Don’t touch keymap” and hit “Enter”.

Hit “Enter” to start Clonezilla at “Start_Clonezilla”

Select “device-image work with disks or partitions using images” and hit “Enter.”



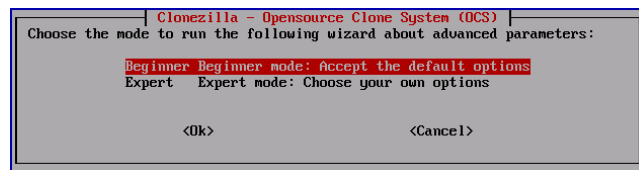
Choose “local_dev use local device”

Make sure external HDD is plugged in and turned on, then press “Enter”

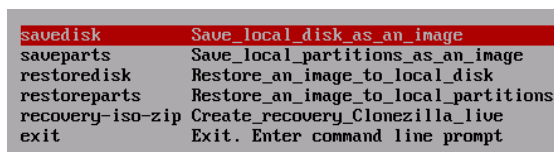
At “mount a device” screen, use the arrow keys to choose the drive you want to save the image to (i.e. the HDD)

The next screen asks which directory is for the Clonezilla image. Choose “/ Top directory”

Choose **Beginner Mode**



Choose “Save Disk” from the list



Give the image a unique name(the current date will be added behind the scenes)

Choose “local disk as source” of the image and hit ‘Enter’

Type “y” and hit enter...do this each time you are prompted to confirm an action. Allow the clone to complete.
(This should only take a few minutes.)

Press “enter” to continue when prompted.

Type “1” to reboot and hit “Enter.” Eject the CD-ROM when prompted, and press “Enter”.

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If you want to use Clonezilla again:
(1) Stay in this console (console 1), enter command line prompt
(2) Run command "exit" or "logout"
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When everything is done, remember to use 'poweroff', 'reboot' or follow the menu to do a normal poweroff/reboot procedure. Otherwise if the boot media you are using is a writable device (such as USB flash drive), and it's mounted, poweroff/reboot in abnormal procedure might make it FAIL to boot next time!
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Press "Enter" to continue...
You you can choose to:
(0) Poweroff
(1) Reboot
(2) Enter command line prompt
(3) Start over

Deploying an Image with Clonezilla

Insert the Clonezilla CD into the computer that what you want to deploy the image to, plug in the External HDD (which houses the image), turn it on and then power on the computer. Press F12 as it boots. Choose to boot from the CD and press Enter to begin when the splash screen appears.

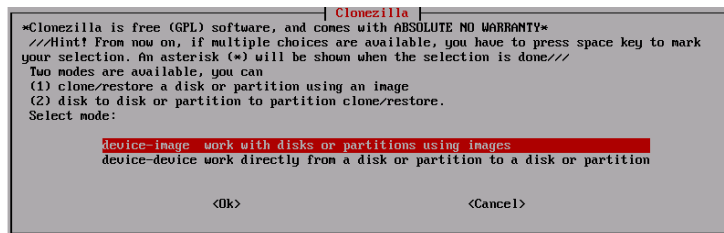


Hit “Enter” to accept en_US.UTF-8 English.

Select “Don’t touch keymap” and hit “Enter”.

Hit “Enter” to start Clonezilla at “Start_Clonezilla”

Select “device-image work with disks or partitions using images” and hit “Enter.”



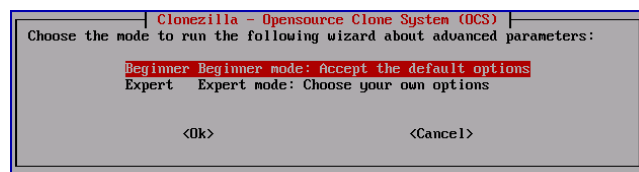
Choose “local_dev use local device”

Make sure external HDD is plugged in and turned on, then press “Enter”

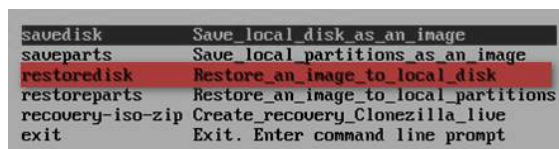
At “mount a device” screen, use the arrow keys to choose the drive you want to save the image to (i.e. the HDD)

The next screen asks which directory is for the Clonezilla image. Choose “/ Top directory”

Choose **Beginner Mode**



Choose “RestoreDisk” from the list



Then choose the appropriate image for the disk according to the image name
Choose target disk for the image and press “Enter” twice.

Type “y” and hit enter...do this each time you are prompted to confirm an action. Allow the deployment to complete. (This should only take a few minutes.)
Press “enter” to continue when prompted.
Type “1” to reboot and hit “Enter.” Eject the CD-ROM when prompted, and press “Enter”.

The image has been deployed.
